Travel Bratislava to Eastern Slovakia

- Fly Pittsburgh to Vienna (via Dulles)
- Scenic trip north: Trnava, Trenčín, Žilina, Martin and historical villages East to Poprad and Tatra Mountains, Levoča, Spiš Castle, to Prešov
- After workcamp: Košice, across southern route to Vienna
- Tour Slovak capital of Bratislava

Work Camp Hermanovce nad Toplou

- Enlarge church camp facilities
- Minor church repairs & improvements
- Informal after-school recreation
- Teach English in elementary school
- Work with Roma church in Hlinné
- Work with Slovak Christian friends
